ORDERS ON PENDING MOTIONS

This cause has previously been assigned to this Division for trial. Hearing called in order to dispose of all pending motions and preliminary matters. The State appears through Joseph L. Bauer, Assistant Circuit Attorney, and the defendant appears in person and represented by retained counsel Robert A. Hampe.

A review of the file in this cause reveals the following motions, and this Court enters its orders in regard thereto as follows:

- a) Defendant's motion to limit cross-examination, to prevent the use of prior convictions to impeach, filed 12/28/82, submitted this date and overruled;
- b) Defendant's motion challenging the "death qualification" of jurors, filed 12/28/82, submitted this date and overruled;
- c) Defendant's motion for individual voir dire of prospective jurors and for sequestration of the trial jury, filed 12/28/82, submitted this date, and it is ordered that the trial jury selected to hear this cause shall be sequestered as provided by Missouri statute and that this Court will order a limited individual voir dire of the prospective jurors as discussed and set forth in the record on this motion, but the request for a strict individual voir dire of each prospective juror is overruled;
- d) Defendant's motion for a new jury on the issue of sentencing together with an amendment thereto, filed 12/28/82, submitted this date and overruled;



- e) Defendant's motion in limine to prohibit the prosecutor from asking prospective jurors their views of the death penalty and to prohibit the prosecutor from mentioning the range of punishment, filed 12/28/82, submitted this date and overruled;
- f) Defendant's renewed motion for a bill of particulars or in the alternative for discovery of evidence in aggravation, filed 2/24/83, submitted this date as set forth in the record of this hearing together with the statements and agreements of counsel therein;
- g) Defendant's motion in limine to prevent the prosecutor from mentioning the polygraph examination of the defendant and the results thereof, filed 5/3/83, submitted this date and sustained;
- h) Defendant's motion in limine on the possible testimony of [REDACTED] regarding their identification of the defendant from photos, filed 5/5/83, submitted this date and to be taken with the case.

The record in this cause also reveals several pending written requests and motions to produce. These matters were discussed in the record. There was no request or motion by the defendant for any Court order in regard thereto since the matters contained have been resolved by agreement or prior production.


