ORDERS ON DEFENDANT'S MOTIONS FILED ON  
JULY 5, 1983, AND JULY 6, 1983

Hearing called in order to dispose of defendant's motions filed on July 5 and 6, 1983. The State appears through Joseph L. Bauer, Assistant Circuit Attorney, and the defendant appears in person and represented by retained counsel, Robert A. Hampe.

The following motions filed on July 5, 1983, are hereby ruled as follows:

- a) Renewed Motion To Dismiss Or Strike Portion of Indictment: Sustained as to the term "Bad Bill" but reference will be permitted with regard to the name "Bill".
- b) Renewed Motion To Dismiss: Overruled.
- c) Renewed Motion For Production Of Hair Samples: Overruled.
- d) Renewed Motion For The Production Of A Witness For A Psychological/Psychiatric Examination: Overruled.
- e) Renewed Motion For Determination Of Mental Competency Of Witness: Overruled.
- f) Renewed Motion To Enforce Discovery Or In The Alternative For Sanctions: Request for the diary of [REDACTED] is hereby overruled; request for the records, notes, memoranda, etc., in the psychological or professional counseling of [REDACTED] and/or

g) Renewed Motion To Suppress Identification: To be taken with the case without objection.


The following motions filed on July 6, 1983, are hereby ruled as follows:

a) Motion In Limine And In The Alternative Motion For Protective Order: Overruled.

b) Motion To Produce: Sustained, provided however, that the custody of Specimen Q-5 mentioned in paragraph 3 is to remain in the custody of a Police Department employee.

It must be noted that the defendant filed this date his Notice Of Intent To Rely On Alibi Defense and Witness Endorsement. Counsel for the defendant agreed in the record to provide the necessary addresses on the witnesses.
